

Hans-Ueli Vogt

Professor at the University of Zurich, Chair for Private and Business Law

Hans-Ueli Vogt holds the chair for private and business law at the University of Zurich (Switzerland), where he teaches corporate law, contracts, and banking law. He has published books, book chapters, and articles in his areas of practice and has served on various occasions as an expert to the Federal Government, parliamentary committees and international organizations. Hans-Ueli Vogt is a co-editor of the "Zeitschrift für Gesellschafts- und Kapitalmarktrecht" (GesKR), a law review in the field of corporate and securities law, and a frequent speaker at conferences both in Switzerland and abroad. He was a Visiting Professor at Tsinghua University School of Law (Beijing) and at King's College, Department of Law (London), as well as a Visiting Scholar at Harvard Law School and a Jean Monnet Fellow at the European University Institute (Florence). He holds a Ph.D. (Dr. iur.) from the University of Zurich, an LL.M. from New York University School of Law, an MBA from the University of St. Gallen (HSG), and a certificate as an IFRS accountant from the University of Zurich and the Swiss Accounting Academy.

He was an associate in the Litigation Department of Sullivan & Cromwell LLP (New York) and gained professional experience in major Zurich law firms.
